UPJ – Fireworks Display permit; 10/18/2025

- It was moved by Mr. Saylor to approve the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown fireworks display permit, with the event to be held October 18, 2025.

Public Comment

Mr. Strushenksy, Mya Drive asked about the location of project "Reachland" and where the tunnel is proposed to be. Chair Heffelfinger stated that there are multiple grants available at the state level. Any out-of-pocket expenses for the Richland School District are unknown. Mr. Strushensky asked if there are any taxpayer monies being expended at first, and it was stated that they will have to be ongoing maintenance, upkeep, alot like the sidewalks that UPJ installed and maintains.

Mr. Strushensky asked about the fireworks display at the Willows on June 16^{th} . He finds it odd that the Airport is permitting such an event. Mr. Beppler stated that all the necessary approvals, ie. FAA, etc. have been obtained.

A brief discussion was held on residential solar panels and the township's position on them. Chair Heffelfinger gave an explanation about zoning regulations, concerns with decommissioning them in the future, lifespan, etc. He noted that the panels are considered hazardous waste material.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
